Regulation 18 - Insurance

This Regulation creates a requirement for childminders to have insurance. Childminding insurance is pre-requirement for Tusla registration, however, a quote for cover will be adequate for the purposes of registration.

The childminder's insurance should include the following: public liability insurance, insurance against fire and theft, buildings insurance and insurance for outings.
