Inspection and Enforcement

Regulation 25 - Inspection

- The Agency shall have regard to the home-based nature and family setting of a childminding service when inspecting a service.
- (2) The Agency shall, following an inspection by an authorised person of a childminding service, furnish a report in writing of the outcome of the inspection to the registered provider of the childminding service.
- (3) Subject to paragraph (2), the Agency shall take such steps as are necessary to enforce these Regulations in relation to the childminding service concerned.

Inspection and Enforcement

Regulation 25 - Inspection

This Regulation requires Tusla to consider the home based nature and family setting when inspecting childminding services. The regulation also sets out the requirement for Tusla to share their inspection report with the childminder. Tusla will provide further guidance in relation to the process of producing a final report. Tusla may meet with a childminder to discuss the report or may engage by email. Tusla will publish the report on their website once it has been finalised.
