Registration and Register

Regulation 6 - Register

- (1) The register shall be available for inspection by members of the public by means of the internet.
- (2) The following details, in addition to those specified in section 58C(2), are prescribed for the purposes of that section as to be contained in the register:
 - (a) the name, if any, of the childminding service;
 - (b) the date from which the registration of the childminding service takes effect (if different from the date of registration);
 - (c) any condition attached to registration;
 - (d) the age profile of the children cared for by the childminder.

Regulation 6 - Register

This regulation sets out the information that will be publicly available on the Tusla register. Tusla is required to make this information available and it will be available on the Tusla website. In addition to the childminder, the childminding service and the date of registration, the Child Care Act also requires that the address and the maximum number of children is also stated on the register.
